看完這段新聞, 感想是:強!

在成本一樣的情況下,對不同的顧客收取不同的價格,經濟學稱之為「價格歧視」或「價格分歧」(Price Discrimination,簡稱 PD)。雖然稱之為「歧視」,但其實此詞並無負面意義,只是一個訂價策略的描述。要做 PD,先決條件是要**有能力區分不同的顧客**:找出誰顧意(亦有能力)付出更多,誰不顧意,然後依此訂不同的價碼。問題是,要區分顧客並不容易,總不能直接問他們吧!因此,港鐵就以年齡和身份區分:年紀小的、在學的,就便宜一點,其他就貴一點,這正是基本的 PD 策略。






