## Joyce Yim's e-portfolio

### Week Four: Online learning activity and learning theories

#### The online learning activity:

I would like to build up a collective on-line portfolio with my students just like what we do in this course. Students build up their own blog in the form of small groups bit by bit through out the semester as a record of their own learning. Instead of just using words, students can post some multimedia elements into their blogs, such as video or sound recordings. Other members of the same class can visit their blogs and give comments. Bonus marks can be given to students who have excellent posts or comments.

#### Rationale for having this activity:

According to constructivism, deep and meaningful understanding only occurs when students participate fully in their own learning, through creating their own blogs, students need to think and design what to be post on their blog. Besides typing in words, they may also have to find relevant materials such as videos or photos. During this process of creating their blogs, students can explore their own knowledge and incorporate these knowledge with their own.

Also, as the blog is a group work which students need to cooperate with other group members, students have to negotiate and communicate with others, which is the essence of collaborative learning. Also, other students in the class can also view the blog and comment on the posts, students can learn from each other and share what they have learnt with others. This gives rise to peer learning among students.

My online quiz is intended for helping students to have a review of what they have learnt in the previous lesson. Key concept/ target language taught in the previous lesson are included in the quiz in order to refresh student's memories after the lesson.

Explanations of the question and answer can be given even teacher is not staying with students while they are taking the quiz. Teachers can have the statistics of how students perform in the quiz so that teachers can have an insight of how much students understand.
